

HEMORRHOID BANDING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. You are scheduled for Hemorrhoid Banding on ______.
- 2. Inform your physician if you have had any of the following conditions:
 - Immunosuppression
 - Cirrhosis of the liver
 - Inflammatory bowel disease, i.e. Crohn's disease, Ulcerative Colitis
 - History of pelvic radiation
- 3. Your physician will possibly require colonoscopy if you have never had one or your last one was over three years ago.
- 4. Please inform your physician if you are on an anticoagulant or other agents with a bleeding risk: Plavix, Pradaxa, Coumadin, Aggrenox, Agrylin, Brilinta, Jantoven, Effient, Elmiron, Heparin, Lovenox, Persantine, Plavix, Pletal, Ticlid, Xarelto). Your physician may want to stop this medication prior to your banding.
- 5. Do not take Viagra or Cialis for 48 hours prior to your visit. Ask your physician when you can restart this medication after your banding.
- 6. Be prepared to stay an additional 10-15 minutes in our office after your banding is performed.
